

I WILL SHARE WITH OTHERS! LESSON 6

Today your children joined a boy named Mardy on a training mission for the Help Corps. On the mission, Mardy went to Cookie Island to help the islanders learn: **I Will Share With Others**. Before he got there, the islanders were all hungry except for Chip, who had all the cookies on the whole island and wouldn't share with anyone. The islanders wanted to steal his cookies for themselves, but then Mardy taught all of them that everything we have comes from God and He wants us to share with others. Chip decided to share his cookies with everyone on the island, and no one was hungry anymore.

Next week, your children will join Mardy on an adventure to Berry Blast Island where he will help someone learn: I Will Thank God.

Activity one: Color With Me

One day this week, sit down to color with your children, and give them all the crayons while you keep the paper. Tell them that if they share their crayons with you, you'll share your paper with them. Then as you color a picture together, talk about how God wants us to share with others.

Activity two: Share a Meal

With the help of your children, make some extra dinner one night this week and deliver it to a friend or neighbor. Talk to them about how we should share everything we have because it all comes from God, and that sharing food with someone who is sick, busy, or tired is a nice thing to do.
